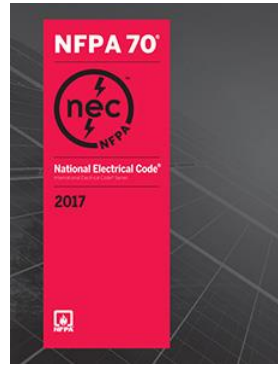


NEC CODE UPDATES
