- Must be 17 years of age, and have high school diploma or GED
- Valid driver's license & own transportation
- Cannot have any felony convictions in your background
- Must pass a drug screening test



The training YOU receive:

Is paid for by your employer and can count towards college credit. Resulting in no student loans and is registered with the PA and US Department of labor!

Advanced placement testing available upon request.



Apprentices:

Work full time in the electrical field and are eligible for Veteran's Education Benefits. While getting paid for their work, there is also a minimum pay scale raise for every 1,000 hours of work. Class is attended twice a week from September to April with instructor led classes in person or online.

To fulfill an IEC apprenticeship, you must:

Complete 576 hours of related technical instruction training and 8,000 hours of on-the-job training which is usually completed in about four or five years.
